Commitment to achieving Net Zero

MSC Digital Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline emissions footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.:

Baseline Year: 01/01/2023 – 31/12/2023

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.

MSC Digital Limited's baseline reporting year is 2023 as it is the first year in which the company is measuring its emissions in order to execute a Carbon Reduction Plan for future years, with the goal of emitting net zero carbon by 2050 at the latest.

As MSC Digital Limited owns and controls the full extent of its business operations, all parts of MSC Digital Limited fall within the scope of this Carbon Reduction Plan.

MSC Digital Limited is a fully remote company with no business premises or company vehicles which would use electricity, gas, or petrol, or waste disposal or recycling services. MSC Digital Limited's GHG emissions derive from employee and contractor business travel.

Emissions have been calculated using the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero's condensed conversion factors for 2023

(https://assets.publishing.service.gov.uk/government/uploads/system/uploads/attachment_data/file/1166236/ghg-conversion-factors-2023-condensed-set-update.xlsx).

Calculations are based on: medium petrol passenger vehicles; regular taxis; local busses; national rail; and hotels outside of London. Calculations are based on number of km travelled per individual to primary client site, assuming 12d/year of travel.

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction target.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 10.0 tCO₂e by 2028. This is a reduction of 23%.

Carbon reduction initiatives

We will achieve these targets by implementing policies to reduce business travel and, where possible, to limit business travel to day return (reducing hotel usage) and public transport (reducing emissions from travel by petrol car).

Progress against these targets will be published in the Carbon Reduction Plans for future years.

Certification against ISO 14001 is also under consideration by the company and is being assessed via our Quality Management System to determine if it is right and proportionate for a business of our size and turnover.

MSC Digital Limited also intends to participate in verified carbon offsetting projects in order to offset our total emissions. Senior leadership is currently considering offsetting options. Our objective under this plan is to become carbon-neutral by 2030.

Declaration and sign-off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard.

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been reviewed and signed off by the board of directors.
